“OSHA Recordkeeping”

Effective January 1, 2015, OSHA revised its Recordkeeping Rule. This presentation will bring you up to date on current requirements including the new reporting requirements for hospitalizations, amputations and loss of an eye, as well as online reporting. Did you know?

- Not all Bureau of Workers’ Compensation workers’ comp claims or emergency room visits are OSHA recordable
- Non-compliance in recordkeeping can cost your company thousands of dollars
