“Making a Positive Difference in Construction Safety and Health by Improving Safety Climate & Safety Leadership”

This presentation will provide an overview of new tools for construction contractors and others in the industry to improve and strengthen safety climate and safety leadership on the jobsite. Attendees will receive copies of CPWR’s workbook “Worksheets and a Rating Tool to Help Strengthen Jobsite Safety Climate,” view the new Safety Climate Assessment Tool (S-CAT) website, and learn about the new Foundations for Safety Leadership (FSL) module that is now an elective in the OSHA 30-hour course but is used by many companies as a stand-alone course.

Our presenter is Dr. Linda Goldenhar, Director of Research and Evaluation at the Center for Constructive Research and Training (CPWR). Dr. Goldenhar received her PhD in Public Health and served as a Research Psychologist at NIOSH focusing on construction-related issues. Her scholarly work over 29 years encompasses a wide variety of public health topics and includes over 60 publications, symposia and workshops. She has presented at hundreds of conferences including ASSE Safety and Health meetings.
